**Please note:**

- Test applications must accompany a complete application to compete in the competition event corresponding to this test.
- If taking an interpretive test, it is necessary to enter the event at which you will be testing. For example, if you wish to take the Silver Interpretive test, you must enter the Silver Interpretive event as it will not be possible for a skater to enter the Bronze Interpretive event even although the music program time could be the same.
- A test fee of \$20.00 *per test portion* must accompany this application.
- Interpretive test fee is \$10.00.
- A money order (**separate from that for the competition**) dated no later than 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 is to be made out to **Skate Dartmouth**.
- Tests may not be withdrawn within 14 days of the scheduled event (rule 4105). Tests withdrawn after this date without medical documentation will be recorded as a retry. If a test is withdrawn, a skater is still subject to withdrawal policy of the competition if they also withdraw from the competitive event.
- As the tests will be conducted during the actual competitive skating event entered, the schedule for the test is identical to your competition schedule.
- Remember - tests will be scheduled depending on judge availability.
